
Have an irrigation emergency after 5 PM? Call 1-866-263-3988



The Master Association has an afterhours answering service in place to handle calls related to irrigation emergencies after 5 PM. You can call the service directly at 866-263-3988. Calls that come in are immediately texted to the Master's Water Team which consists of approximately 10 technicians and staff members who can remotely shut down the system within a few minutes. If there is an issue that cannot be resolved remotely, a technician is dispatched to the property. All afterhours emergency issues are investigated and scheduled for repair the following morning.

If you have an irrigation EMERGENCY (Mainline Break, Water is pouring into a dwelling, water is destroying property, or affecting the roadways) and its outside normal business hours call 1-866-263-3988. Please do not use the emergency number for NON-EMERGENCY irrigation issues. Please call 813-812-7559 and leave a message instead.
